

Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Plan

The funds from Proposition 28 are dedicated funds from the State's budget to guarantee that all public-school students have access to high quality arts education and music programs. Allowable expenditures include, but are not limited to instruction and training, supplies, materials and arts educational partnership programs, for instruction in dance, media arts, music, theatre, and visual arts. Per Ed Code 8820(g)(4), an annual report and plan is required to be approved by the Board.

McCabe Union Elementary School District received an allocation of \$170,524 for Prop 28 for the 23-24 school year. Per statutory requirements, 80% of funds to be expended will be used to employ certificated or classified employees to provide arts education instruction and the remaining funds will be used for training, supplies, and materials, and arts education partnership programs.

McCabe School District will use Prop 28 to pay 1 FTE of a credential art teacher to provide art instruction to students in 4th-8th grade and .10FTE of an Instructional Aide to assist. McCabe will utilize Prop 28 to procure art supplies for the art classes.
